WHAT: Camping - Hammocks Beach State Park, NC

WHEN: September 12-13, 2009

WHERE: Hammocks Beach State Park (Bear Island), Near Swansboro, NC

MEET: 5:00AM Saturday, September 11 at Coachman's Trail Clubhouse; Departing 5:30 AM or Sooner

RETURN: 3:00PM Sunday, September 12, Coachman's Trail Clubhouse

COST:

- \$12 Troop Grub money (to be collected Saturday morning, September 11).
- Scouts should also bring money for two restaurant stops; one stop for Breakfast Saturday morning and one stop for Lunch on Sunday.
- \$50 per person (payable to Troop 215) for Kayaking. This activity is limited to 2nd Year or older Scouts with the Swimming Merit Badge. Troop 215 will make final determinations for eligibility.
- \$5 per person (\$3 per person if 12yrs or younger) for round trip State Park Ferry transportation to and from Bear Island for all other Scouts and Adults not Kayaking.

DRESS: We will travel in our complete Class A uniform, swim trunks during water/beach activities, and our Troop 215 Class B uniform should be worn at all other times..

NOTES: Bear Island is accessible only by passenger ferry operated by the State Park or by private boat. We'll travel to the island via the State Park ferry or by sea kayak (see Troop email for details). Once on the island we'll be doing a number of activities depending on weather conditions that include a beach hike to Bear Inlet; fishing and possibly clamming or crabbing; and beach/swimming.
